



# Zuid-Afrikaanshe Boer Republics

## International Observers and Institutions Notified for Observation

### Purpose

This attachment lists key international institutions and bodies that have been notified (or invited for observation) regarding the Zuid-Afrikaansche *Boervolk's* petition to the United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues (UNPFII). The purpose is to promote transparency, peaceful dialogue, and international awareness of the *Boervolk's* pursuit of cultural self-determination under UNDRIP (2007). These notifications are issued in a spirit of peace, without request for enforcement or adjudication, but as a record of the *Boervolk's* commitment to open and respectful engagement with the global community.

### 1. Rationale for Notification

The *Boervolk's* historical and cultural journey has international dimensions, including diplomatic recognition in the 19<sup>th</sup> century and contemporary concerns for indigenous rights. Notifying these bodies ensures:

- Global observation of the peaceful process.
- Alignment with UNDRIP principles of dialogue and cooperation (Articles 18 and 41).

- Historical accuracy in the recognition of the *Boervolk's* distinct identity and experiences as a people.

## **2. Key International Institutions Notified or Invited as Observers**

The following bodies have been placed on notice or invited to observe the process (for informational purposes only):

- **United Nations**
  - Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues (UNPFII) – primary recipient.
  - Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR).
  - Special Rapporteur on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.
- **African Union**
  - African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights (ACHPR) – for regional observation of indigenous rights in Africa.
- **UNESCO**
  - World Heritage and Intangible Cultural Heritage sections – for awareness of Boer cultural sites and traditions.
- **International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)**
  - For historical context on humanitarian aspects of past conflicts affecting civilians.
- **Selected Foreign Governments (as Observers)**
  - Governments with historical ties or interest in indigenous rights (e.g., Netherlands, United States, Hungary) – notified for diplomatic awareness.

## **3. Nature of Notification** These notifications are:

- Peaceful and informational only.
- Without prejudice to any rights or positions.
- Intended to foster understanding and dialogue, in line with the *Boervolk's* white flag declaration of non-belligerence.
