Deur: Tydelike Adviesraad (TAR), namens die Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk

Inleiding

Die Tydelike Adviesraad van die Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republieke (ZABR) is verkies om die vestiging van die Volksraad, Uitvoerende Raad, en Volkshof te fasiliteer, soos gemagtig deur die ZAB Deklarasie van Onafhanklikheid van “100 man” (Kulturele Selfbeskikking) van 12 Julie 2025 ([Bylaag J](#) van die konsep Grondwet). Die ZABR funksioneer as ’n kulturele en administratiewe liggaam wat die Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB of Boervolk hierna) se historiese volkereg herstel en hul kulturele, taalkundige, en historiese identiteit beskerm, in ooreenstemming met die beginsels van selfbeskikking onder internasionale reg, soos die VN-Verklaring oor Inheemse Volke (UNDRIP, 2007). Hierdie verklaring formaliseer die Adviesraad se mandaat, wat weerspieël word in die konsep ZABR Grondwet, en bevestig sy rol as ’n tydelike liggaam om die ZAB se historiese kulturele soewereiniteit vreedsaam te bevorder.

Mandaat

Die Tydelike Adviesraad se mandaat spruit direk uit die ZAB Deklarasie van Onafhanklikheid van “100 Man”, onderteken deur 100 gemagtigde volksgenote, en is in lyn met die konsep ZABR Grondwet. Die mandaat sluit die volgende in:

1. **Fasiliteer die Volksraad:** Organiseer die aanstelling van ’n permanente Volksraad deur gemeenskapsdeelname en die Volksregister, om die Boervolk se kulturele en administratiewe verteenwoordiging te versterk.
2. **Bestuur Administrasie:** Toesig hou oor die Volksregister, emansipasie-proses, en ZABR se kulturele en administratiewe aktiwiteite, insluitend die dokumentasie van die Boervolk se erfenis.
3. **Bevorder Soewereiniteit (Historiese en Kulturele Erfenis):** Verteenwoordig die Boervolk in plaaslike en internasionale forums, insluitend kennisgewings aan die RSA, VN, en AU, om kulturele en territoriale regte te bepleit.
4. **Beskerm Kultuur:** Bewaar die Boervolk se kulturele erfenis en historiese volkereg (Sandrivier-konvensie 1852, Bloemfontein-konvensie 1854), terwyl die ongeldige anneksasie van 1902 verwerp word.

Kulturele en Administratiewe Rol

Die ZABR se Tydelike Adviesraad tree op as ’n kulturele en administratiewe liggaam wat gefokus is op die bewaring van die Boervolk se identiteit, taal, en historiese regte. Dit is nie ’n parallelle regering wat die territoriale integriteit van enige staat uitdaag nie, maar ’n vreedsame entiteit wat selfbeskikking nastreef in lyn met internasionale reg en die wit vlag-proses van die Deklarasie. Die Adviesraad se aktiwiteite is in ooreenstemming met die konsep ZABR Grondwet, wat voorsiening maak vir die tydelike rol van die Adviesraad totdat die permanente Volksraad aangestel is.

Verkiesing en Magte

- **Verkiesing:** Die Adviesraad is verkies op 24 Augustus 2025 tydens ’n vergadering van tydelike leiers deur middel van ’n formele stem proses en in ooreenstemming met die Deklarasie.
- **Magte:** Die Adviesraad het tydelike magte, soos uiteengesit in die konsep ZABR Grondwet, om kulturele en administratiewe beleid te ontwikkel, die Volksregister te bestuur, en diplomatieke verhoudings te koördineer totdat die Volksraad verkies is.

- **Oorgang:** Die Adviesraad sal ontbind sodra die Volksraad formeel aangestel is.

Vreedsame Bedoelings

In lyn met die wit vlag-proses van die Deklarasie, tree die Adviesraad vreedsaam op om die Zuid-Afrikaanse Boervolk se selfbeskikking te bevorder, sonder konfrontasie met die RSA of ander state. Alle aktiwiteite is gerig op kulturele bewaring en die herstel van historiese regte deur wettige en diplomatieuse kanale.

Temporary Advisory Council

Mandate statement

Issued by: Temporary Advisory Council on behalf of the *Zuid-Afrikaanshe Boervolk* (ZAB)

Date: November 2025

Introduction

The Temporary Advisory Council of the Zuid-Afrikaanshe Boer Republieke (ZABR) was elected to facilitate the establishment of the People's Council, Executive Council, and People's Court, as authorized by the ZAB Declaration of Independence of "100 men" (Cultural Self-Determination) of 12 July 2025 ([Appendix J](#) of the draft Constitution). The ZABR functions as a cultural and administrative body that restores the Boer Volk's historical *international law* and protects their cultural, linguistic, and historical identity, in accordance with the principles of self-determination under international law, such as the UN Declaration on Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP, 2007). This declaration formalises the Advisory Council's mandate, which is reflected in the draft ZABR Constitution, and reaffirms its role as a temporary body to peacefully promote the Boer Volk's historically cultural sovereignty.

Mandate

The Temporary Advisory Council's mandate stems directly from the ZAB Declaration of Independence of "100 Men", signed by 100 authorized fellows, and is in line with the draft ZABR Constitution. The mandate includes the following:

1. **Facilitate the Volksraad:** Organise the appointment of a permanent Volksraad through community participation and the Volksregister, to strengthen the Boer Volk's cultural and administrative representation.
2. **Management Administration:** Overseeing the National Register, emancipation process, and ZABR's cultural and administrative activities, including the documentation of the Boer Volk's heritage.
3. **Promote Sovereignty (Historical and Cultural Heritage):** Represent the Boer Volk in local and international forums, including notifications to the RSA, UN, and AU, to advocate for cultural and territorial rights.
4. **Protect Culture:** Preserve the Boer Volk's cultural heritage and historical *international law* (Sand River Convention 1852, Bloemfontein Convention 1854), while rejecting the invalid annexation of 1902.

Cultural and Administrative Role

The ZABR and its Temporary Advisory Council act as a cultural and administrative body focused on the preservation of the Boer Volk's identity, language, and historical rights. It is not a parallel government that challenges the territorial integrity of any state, but a peaceful entity that pursues self-determination in line with international law and the white flag process of the Declaration. The Advisory Council's activities are in accordance with the draft ZABR Constitution, which provides for the temporary role of the Advisory Council until the permanent People's Council is appointed.

Election and powers

1. **Election:** The Advisory Council was elected on 24 August 2025 at a meeting by community leadership through a formal voting process and in accordance with the Declaration.
2. **Powers:** The Advisory Council has temporary powers, as outlined in the draft ZABR Constitution, to develop cultural and administrative policies, manage the Population Register, and coordinate diplomatic relations until the Volksraad is appointed.

3. **Transition:** The Advisory Council will dissolve once the Volksraad is formally appointed.

Peaceful Intentions

In line with the white flag process of the Declaration, the Advisory Council acts peacefully to promote the self-determination of the Boer Volk, without confrontation with the RSA or other states. All activities are aimed at cultural preservation and the restoration of historical rights through legal and diplomatic channels.
