

ZUID-AFRIKAANSCH E BOER REPUBLICS – MEDIA STATEMENT NOTIFICATION OF BOERVOLK STATUS CORRECTION TO UNPFII

To: The Boervolk, the President of South Africa, members of the South African Government, world leaders, political parties, interested parties, and all others concerned: Please be advised that —

The Temporary Advisory Council, on behalf of the living Boervolk collectively united under the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB) and administered by the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republics (ZABR), hereby notifies of our submission to the United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues (UNPFII) on 26 February 2026. This step, taken in peace and under the guidance of the Almighty Heavenly Father, is a notification for the restoration of record to the UNPFII by the ZABR.

Declaration The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk hereby formally declares that the Boer people IS an indigenous and separate people, in accordance with the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP, 2007). This submission is simply a notice for restoration of record, thereby correcting historical misclassification, colonial subjugation, and forced assimilation. The ZAB reject any submission to external jurisdiction and claim their inherent right to self-identification, self-determination and cultural protection, without prejudice to any rights.

Background The ZAB's Declaration of Independence of "100 Men" (12 July 2025) provides the collective mandate of the Boervolk to the ZABR, representative of all historical Boer Republics, while the Boer Declaration of the ZAB, outlines these principles and objectives.

Key Messages

1. The submission is a peaceful status correction, not a petition for permission, and rejects any submission to external jurisdiction. It focuses on the Boervolk's inherent right to self-identification, self-determination and cultural protection, with recognition of equal rights of peoples as emphasised by the UN. The facts and history speak for themselves –*No Case to Answer*.
2. Since the unlawful British annexation of the Cape (1795, 1806), Natal (12 May 1843) and finally of all historical Boer Republics on 31 May 1902, the Boervolk have been deprived of her identity, property and rights. The Treaty of Vereeniging was a forced surrender, not a victory. Subsequently, in 1910 the British Empire forced its artificial entity, the Union of South Africa, onto the Boervolk, putting several nations into one country. The unlawful British annexation since 1795 and no treaties or agreements since 1902 are recognised. This submission corrects historical wrongs, administrative oppression, as well as assimilation, integration and dilution with other groups. As decided in the Richtersveld case (2003),

colonial (unlawful) annexation does not extinguish indigenous title – a principle that supports the Boervolk's historical land rights and confirms the invalidity of all post-1902 agreements.

3. The submission highlights historical injustices and wrongs as well as continuous contemporary marginalisation and threats and calls for peaceful recognition. It also emphasises the fact that the Boervolk was already internationally recognised as a sovereign people (1841, 1852, 1854), her recognised administration, republics, post stamps and own currency.
4. The ZABR demands self-determination for all historic Boer republics collectively, with a theocratic-socialist Constitution based on the full Word of the Almighty Heavenly Father. The ZABR recognises that the Boervolk's unique identity, volkereg and Vows, exists because of her trust in Him as the source of her existence and culture as a separate people, and not through man-made structures, institutions or statutes.
5. Furthermore, the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk declare that she wants to be a people again to her Almighty Heavenly Father and will strive to return to His will and truth from which our people have strayed. The ZAB realise and acknowledge that her salvation will come from no man, group, organisation or government, but only from her Heavenly Father alone. Thus, she plea only before Him for her freedom, sovereignty and self-determination, without conflict.

Call: We invite Boer compatriots to read the submission on our website and be part of our Volkshuis in unity. The ZABR welcomes all compatriots who accept the Almighty's Word as the only Authority and contribute to justice and the Boervolk's freedom.
