Issued by: The Temporary Advisory Council (TAR), on behalf of the living Boervolk collective, jointly united under the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB), administered by the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republics (ZABR).

To: The Boervolk, all heritage bodies, museums, researchers and the broader public.

PREAMBLE

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republics (ZABR) acknowledges the sacred duty to preserve the historical legacy of the Boervolk. This Heritage Charter serves as the highest policy framework for all heritage preservation, historical research, cultural protection and educational initiatives of the ZABR.

It flows from the mandate of the Declaration of Independence of “100 Men” (12 July 2025), the Declaration of Restoration (ZABR_Openb_Ver_005) and the Declaration of Historical Principles (ZABR_Openb_Ver_006) and is grounded in the Word of the Almighty as the highest authority.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Heritage Charter is to protect and transmit the historical truth, cultural identity and physical heritage of the Boervolk to future generations. It serves as a guideline for the preservation of the legacy of all historical Boer Republics.

2. FOUNDING PRINCIPLES

The ZABR Heritage Charter is based on the following foundational principles:

1. **Truth above propaganda** — Historical facts and primary sources must take precedence.
2. **Stewardship** — We are temporary custodians of a heritage that belongs to future generations.
3. **Preservation above destruction** — Historical sites, graves, monuments and artefacts must be protected.
4. **Respect for all victims** — Dignified commemoration of Boer as well as British and other parties involved.
5. **Documentation and research** — Primary sources, records and oral history must be systematically preserved.
6. **Independence** — Heritage work must be free from party-political influence.
7. **Covenantal Responsibility** — The Boervolk’s heritage is the responsibility of the Boervolk, not that of the broader Afrikaner grouping or foreign entities. It remains her responsibility and must be managed and preserved by her in obedience to the Almighty and the Vows of our predecessors.
8. **Future-oriented** — Everything we do must enable future generations to know and continue their identity as Boervolk.

3. AREAS OF APPLICATION

This Charter applies to:

- Historical sites, battlefields and graves sites of all Boer Republics;
- Monuments and memorial places;
- Museums, archives and collections;
- Digital and physical documentation;
- Educational programmes and research;
- Cooperation with other entities where it serves the Boervolk’s heritage.

4. MOTTO

Preserve what is sacred. For the coming generations. For the truth. For history.

5. CLOSING AFFIRMATION

The ZABR hereby accepts the stewardship over the Boervolk's heritage. May the Almighty guide us to preserve it with faithfulness, truth and dignity.

Reservation of Rights

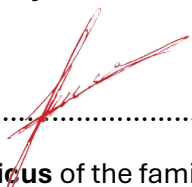

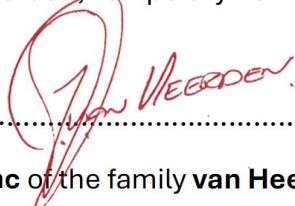
