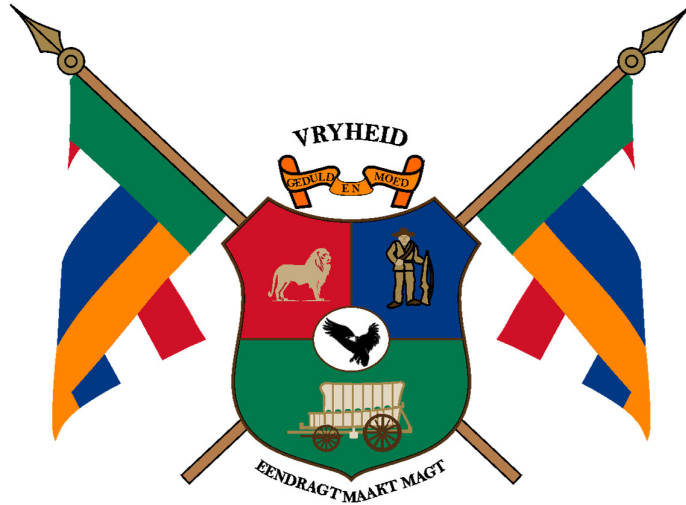

CORRECTION OF STATUS AND ZABR ID

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To: All political parties, cultural organisations, heritage bodies, movements, individuals and Boervolk compatriots

ISSUED BY: The Temporary Advisory Council (TAR) of the South African Boer Republics (ZABR), administered on behalf of the Collective Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB) in terms of the ZAB Declaration of Independence of "100 Men" (12 July 2025) and the draft ZABR Constitution.

Subject: Public Notice of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk's Process of Requesting Correction of Status and ZABR Cultural Identity Document.

1. Introduction

The Temporary Advisory Council of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republics hereby brings to the attention of all stakeholders the official process of **Request for Correction of Status** and the issuance of the **ZABR Cultural Identity Document**.

This process is not the establishment of a new movement or organization. *It is the restoration of the inherent, historical, and covenantal status of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk as a separate, indigenous people.*

2. Basis of the Process

The process of Restoration of Status is based, among others, on the following statements and documentation:

1. The ZAB's Declaration of Independence of "100 Men" (July 12, 2025)
2. The Boer Declaration of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk
3. The ZAB Ethos
4. The draft ZABR Constitution
5. The ZABR's Submission to the UNPFII (February 26, 2026)
6. The Declaration of Restoration Gazette (#54356 of 20 March 2026 General Notice 3833)
7. The Declaration of Heritage Charter
8. The Notice of Identity, Independence, and Non-Affiliation

3. Principles of Restoring Status

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk confirm the following:

1. Self-determination and self-administration

It is a people's inherent right and responsibility to administer herself, determine her own future, and conduct her own affairs.

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk are competent to dispose of themselves and are in the process of restoring themselves as a sovereign people.

2. Preserving History and Legacy

It is a people's duty to preserve and care for her own history, heritage, and legacy. Posterity remains her own obligation.

3. Rejection of foreign domination

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk reject

1. the Treaty of Vereeniging, which was forcibly enforced on the Boervolk by means of national extermination;
2. the domination by alien entities and institutions;
3. forced Afrikaner nationalism
4. and the party-political system to which we have been subjected.

4. Spiritual and Covenant Restoration

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk strive to live as a people for their Almighty Heavenly Father. By putting Him first, obeying His Word, serving Him and fearing

Him. By taking her spiritual responsibility upon herself as a people. The Correction of Status is a spiritual as well as a physical act.

5. Recognition of the ZABR's mandate

Compatriots recognize and accept the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republics as a sovereign and folk-owned cultural administration with a mandate of the living collective Boervolk, with a focus on the preservation and international law of the Boervolk as a unique and historically internationally recognized people.

6. Clear identity declaration

Compatriots who add them to the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk declare not only who they are, but also who they are not.

7. Boervolk Unity and a new beginning

This act is a public and symbolic statement

1. that compatriots detach themselves from the RSA jurisdiction;
2. those compatriots deliberately side with the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk;
3. to realize self-determination as a people;
4. and to be able to live as a people for the Almighty.

4. Nature of the Process

Compatriots (Fellow-nationals) do not become part of a group or movement, they add themselves to the living Boervolk, the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk, which is in the process of fulfilling its Vows as a people – by no longer just promising, but by acting, by living it. The ZABR cultural ID serves to confirm a compatriot's principles and beliefs.

5. Call

When the Father's Spirit speaks to you through this notice and can identify with it, it is your responsibility to act.

Take the Choice – **Correct Your Status.**

For the sake of the blood and sacrifice of your ancestors and for the sake of the future of your descendants.

For the sake of survival as a sovereign people and of the Vows made.

6. Conclusion

The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk restore their status – as a people – before their Almighty Heavenly Father. Either you add yourself, or you choose not to. The choice is each one's own to make. We plead with fellow compatriots who, in trust and steadfast principles, to add themselves to the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk in unity.

Reservation of Rights

This document represents a peaceful, good-faith expression of the historical *Boervolk*, pursued collectively and transparently by concerned compatriots, and not on behalf of any organization, political body, commercial entity, or external interest. All statements herein are made solely in the lawful interest, dignity, and protection of the *Boervolk* themselves.

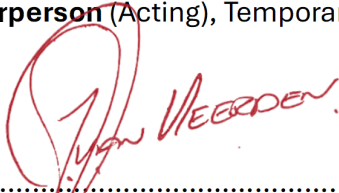
