ISSUED BY: The Temporary Advisory Council (TAR) of the South African Boer Republics (ZABR), administered on behalf of the Collective Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB) in terms of the ZAB Declaration of Independence of "100 Men" (12 July 2025) and the draft ZABR Constitution.

Subject: Public Notice of Volksaffiliation with the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB)

1. Purpose of this Notice

This notice establishes the official framework for voluntary Volksaffiliation with the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB) and the accompanying placement under the cultural and administrative framework of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boer Republieke (ZABR).

This notice serves as a precursor and foundation for:

- The individual Notice of Status Correction (Emancipation) and Affiliation with the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk (ZAB).

2. Foundation

This Volksaffiliation rests upon the following non-negotiable principles:

1. The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk is a living, historical and theocratic people.
2. The full Word of the Almighty Heavenly Father is the highest authority and the sole foundation of the Boervolk's existence, identity and self-governance.
3. The Boervolk is not the same as the broader "Afrikaner" identity. Any movement or individual that absorbs or dilutes Boer identity under a general Afrikaner banner has no mandate to speak or act on behalf of the Boervolk.
4. The historical sovereignty of the Boervolk rests upon the 21+ Boer Republics and is affirmed by the ZAB Declaration of Independence of the "100 Men" (12 July 2025) and the formal submission to the United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues (UNPFII) on 26 February 2026.
5. The ZABR is the only cultural and administrative body with a valid mandate to act on behalf of the Collective Boervolk.

3. Nature of Volksaffiliation

Volksaffiliation with the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk is:

- Voluntary;
- Personal;
- Principle- and Trusts-based;
- Peaceful; and
- Not an automatic transfer of state power or jurisdiction.

By this affiliation the compatriot places himself or herself under the cultural and administrative framework of the ZABR, including the Temporary Advisory Council and the structures arising therefrom.

4. Relationship to other documents

This notice forms the foundation upon which:

- The Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk Lawful Position Statement declares the public and peaceful position of the people;
- The Declaration of Lawful Standing formally places the lawful standing and non-consent position on record; and

- Each individual's Notice of Status Correction and Affiliation constitutes the personal confirmation and record thereof.

5. Reservation of Rights

Nothing in this notice shall be construed as a waiver of any rights, submission to unlawful jurisdiction, or consent to any process to which free agreement has not been given. All rights are expressly reserved.

6. Closing

This notice is issued in the spirit of the White Flag process — in good faith, with the pursuit of peace and justice before the Almighty Heavenly Father, and in confirmation of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Boervolk's rightful existence and self-definition.

Reservation of Rights

This document represents a peaceful, good-faith expression of the historical *Boervolk*, pursued collectively and transparently by concerned compatriots, and not on behalf of any organization, political body, commercial entity, or external interest. All statements herein are made solely in the lawful interest, dignity, and protection of the *Boervolk* themselves.

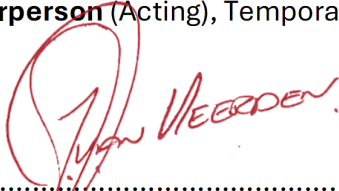

All rights, remedies, and lawful protections are expressly reserved without prejudice. This document affirms respect for lawful authority, due process, human dignity, and peaceful resolution under recognized legal standards.
